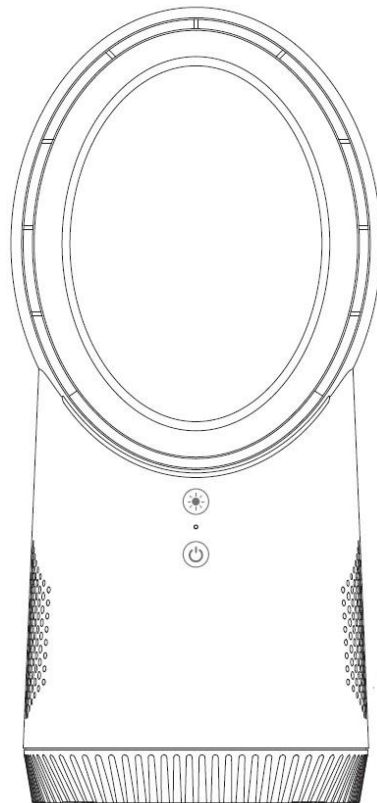



2. No tools are required to assemble your fan, though some assembly is required.

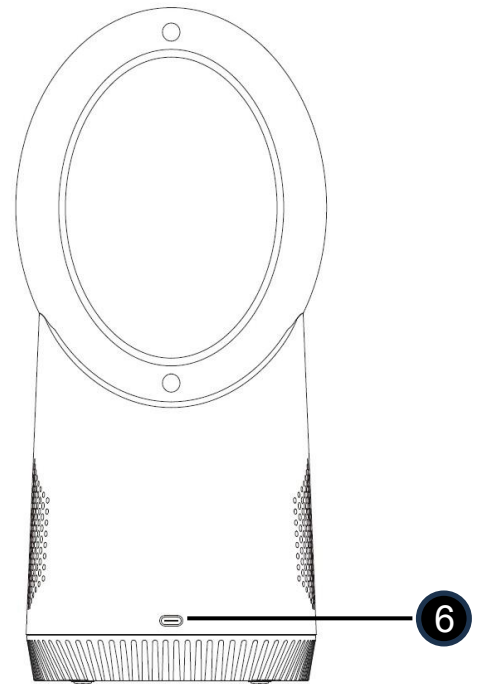
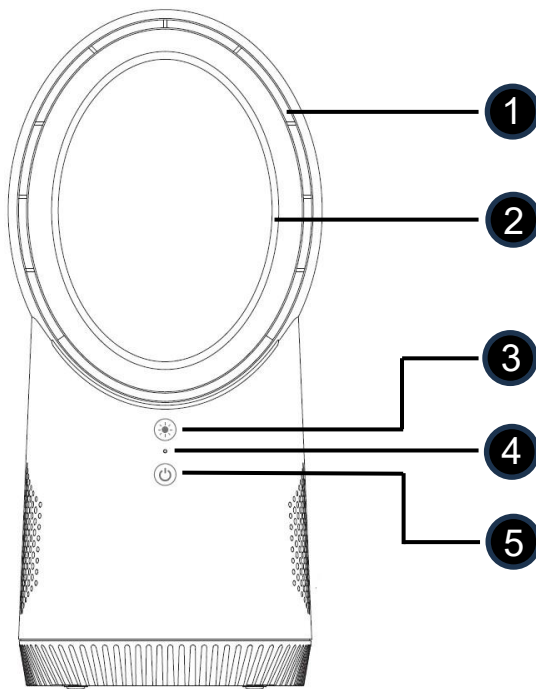
Safety Advice

- **IMPORTANT** – The first step you need to take is to ensure your safety! Please take time to read and understand these instructions before using the product.
- Please keep these instructions for future reference.
- This is a class II product and therefore does not require an earth connection.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children unless they are older than 8 years and with supervision.
- Close supervision is required when using this appliance near children.
- Keep the appliance and its cord out of reach of children less than 8 years.
- Children of less than 3 years should be kept away unless continuously supervised.
- **DO NOT** immerse the appliance or its cord in water or any other liquids.
- Always use this appliance on solid, level, surface.
- **DO NOT** use this appliance outdoors.
- Repairs to electrical appliances should be performed by a qualified electrician. Improper repairs may place user at serious risk.
- **DO NOT** operate this appliance with a damaged plug or cord, after a malfunction or after being dropped or damaged in any way.
- If the power cable is damaged, it should only be replaced by the manufacturer or a suitable qualified-after-sales service in order to avoid a hazard.
- **DO NOT** use any accessories or attachments with this appliance other than those supplied or recommended by the supplier.
- **DO NOT** use this appliance for anything other than intended use.
- **DO NOT** push objects (including fingers) into the fan grill or any openings as this could risk injury or damage to the appliance.
- Always unplug from the mains supply after each use when not in use. Grasp the plug not the cord.
- **DO NOT** leave this appliance unattended when in use.
- **DO NOT** dismantle the fan for cleaning.

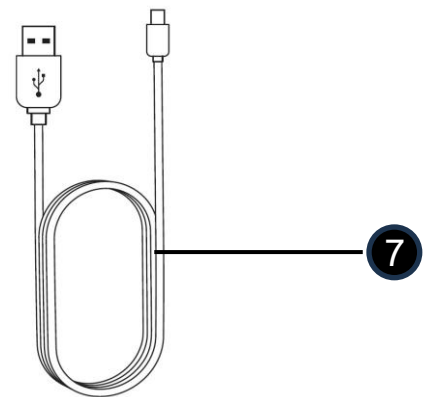

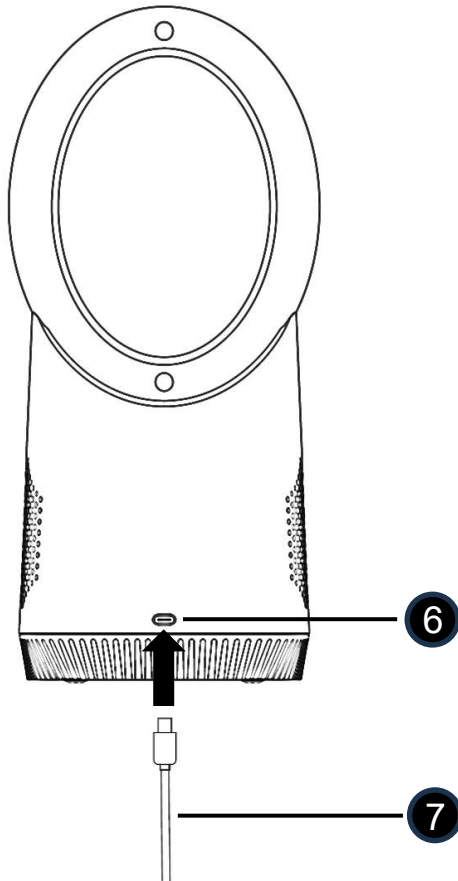

7. USB Charging Cable



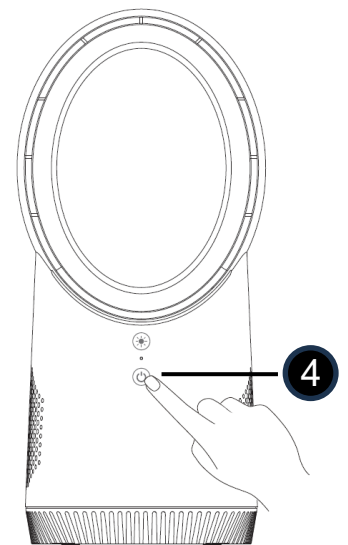


Step 1 – Charging the Internal Battery

1. Insert the USB C-Type plug on the USB Charging Cable (7) into the USB C-Type Socket (6) on the rear of the fan.
2. Plug the large USB plug on the USB Cable (7) into a suitable fast charge (2A) USB outlet.
3. The Indicator Light (4) will flash green to show the internal battery is charging.
4. Once the battery is fully charged (after approximately 5 hours), the Indicator Light (4) will extinguish showing that the internal battery is fully charged and the USB Charging Cable (7) can be removed. **NB** if the Indicator Light (4) flashes red during use the battery will require recharging.

Step 2 – Using the Bladeless Fan

1. Press the On/Off Button (5) for the first time and the Indicator Light (4) will light up white and the fan speed will be Low.
2. Press the On/Off Button (5) a second time, the Indicator Light (4) will light up blue and the fan speed will be Medium.
3. Press the On/Off Button (5) a third time, the Indicator Light (4) will light up green and the fan speed will be High.
4. Press the On/Off Button (5) a fourth time to switch the fan off.



Step 3 – The Ambient Light

1. Press the Ambient Light Button (3) to operate the Ambient Light (2). Press the button repeatedly to select from white, blue, green, red, purple or gradual colour change.
2. Press the Ambient Light Button (3) after the gradual colour change effect to switch the light off.

NB the unit will emit a beep sound each time a button is pressed.

Care and Cleaning

- Ensure that the fan is not connected to the mains supply before cleaning.
- We recommend cleaning the outer body with a soft dry cloth. Do not use abrasive materials as these will damage the finish.
- Do not immerse the fan or its cord in water or any other liquid.

Troubleshooting

Symptom	Possible Solution
Fan not working	Check the USB Cable is inserted in the USB C-Type Socket on the rear of the fan and the cable is plugged into a USB supply.
	Check that On/Off Button has been pressed.
Ambient Light not working	Check that Ambient Light Button has been pressed.
