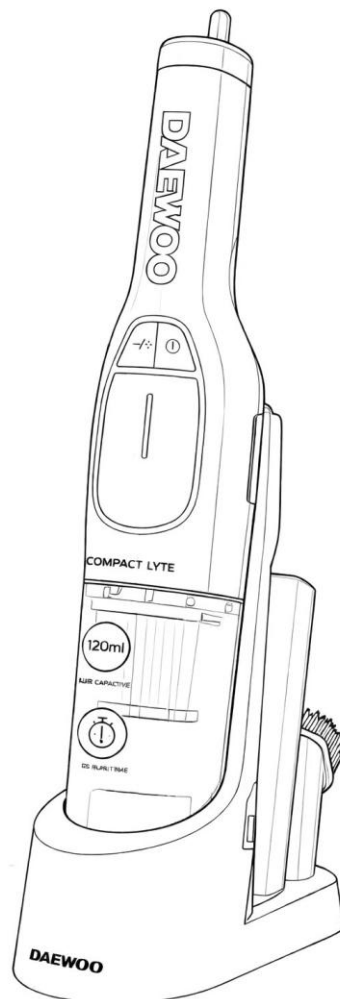




Compact Lyte 7.4V Handheld Vacuum

- Remove all packing materials and discard responsibly.






Safety Advice

- **IMPORTANT** – The first step you need to take is to ensure your safety! Please take time to read and understand these instructions before using the product.
- Please keep these instructions for future reference.
- Check that the voltage indicated on the data plate corresponds with that of the local network before connecting the appliance to the mains power supply.
- This appliance can be used by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.
- Children shall not play with the appliance.
- Keep the appliance and its cord out of reach of children less than 8 years when it is energised or cooling down.
- Do not immerse the appliance or its cable in water or any other liquids.
- Do not leave the appliance unattended during use.
- Do not leave the appliance unattended whilst connected to the power supply.
- The Vacuum can be used outdoors but the power supply must remain indoors.
- It is imperative to unplug the power supply after the appliance has been used, before it is cleaned and whilst being repaired.
- Repairs to electrical appliances should only be performed by a qualified electrician. Improper repairs may place user at serious risk.
- Do not operate this appliance with a damaged power supply or cable, after a malfunction or after being dropped or damaged in any way.



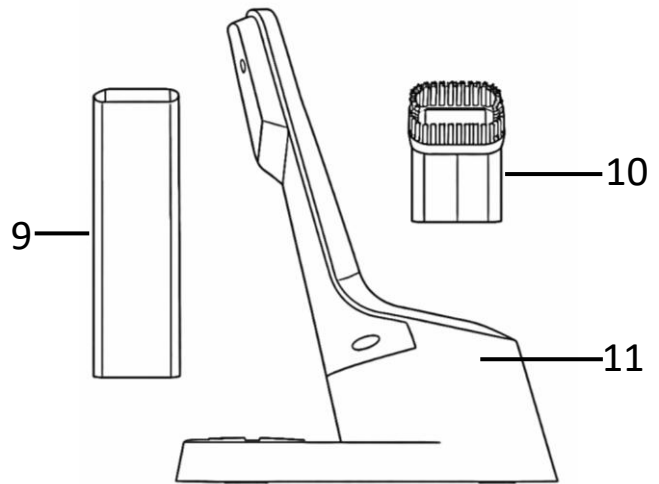
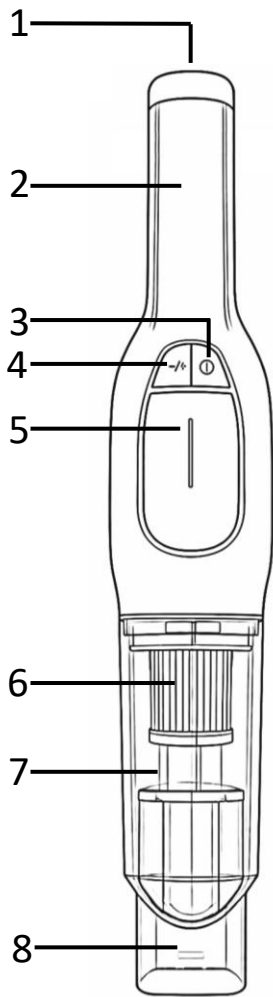
- Regular, periodic checks should be carried out on the cable to ensure no damage is evident. Should there be any signs of damage the appliance should not be used.
- If the cable is damaged, it should only be replaced by the manufacturer or a suitable qualified after-sales-service in order to avoid a hazard
- Do not allow the power cable to hang over sharp edges or come in contact with hot surfaces.
- Do not run the cable under carpets, rugs, etc.
- The Vacuum Cleaner is not to be used if it has been dropped, if there are visible signs of damage.
- Allow the unit to cool before storage.
- Before cleaning, disconnect the appliance from the mains supply and allow to cool.
- This appliance is intended for household use only and should not be used for industrial purposes.
- Do not use any accessories or attachments with this appliance other than those supplied or recommended by supplier.
- Do not use this appliance for anything other than its intended use.
- Do not push objects into any openings as damage to the appliance and/or electric shock may occur.
- Unplug after each use. Grasp the power supply, not the cable.
- Do not pull or carry the Vacuum Cleaner by the cable.
- Never use the appliance without the filter in place.
- Do not use the Vacuum without the Dust Compartment attached.
- Use only on vehicle interior surfaces.
- Do not tilt the Vacuum towards the main body when vacuuming liquids.
- Do not vacuum any large or broken objects such as glass.
- Do not vacuum anything that is burning or smoking such as cigarettes, matches or hot ashes.
- Do not vacuum reactive liquids (solvents, corrosives, detergents).
- Do not vacuum flammable or explosive substances such as alcohol, thinners etc.

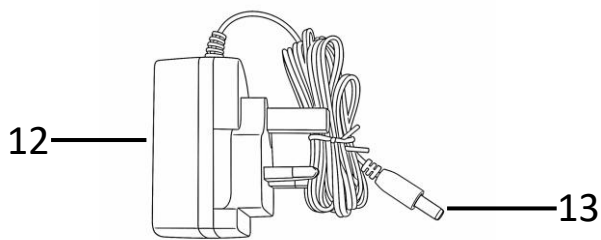

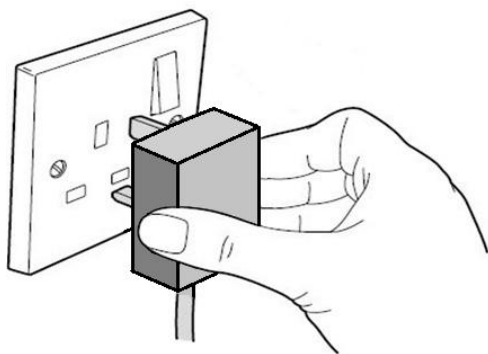
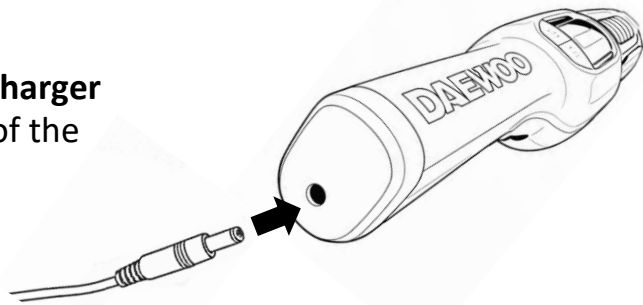

Before use, ensure that the internal battery is fully charged as follows:

Step 1

Insert the **Small Plug** (13) of the **Battery Charger** (12) into the **Charging Port** (1) at the top of the vacuum cleaner **Handle** (2).



Step 2

Plug the **Battery Charger** (12) into the nearest mains socket.

Step 3

The **Battery/Charging LED** (5) will flash to show the internal battery is charging.

Step 4

Once the battery is fully charged (after approximately 5 hours), the **Battery/Charging LED** (5) will all light continuously showing that the internal battery is fully charged and the **Battery Charger** (12) can be removed.

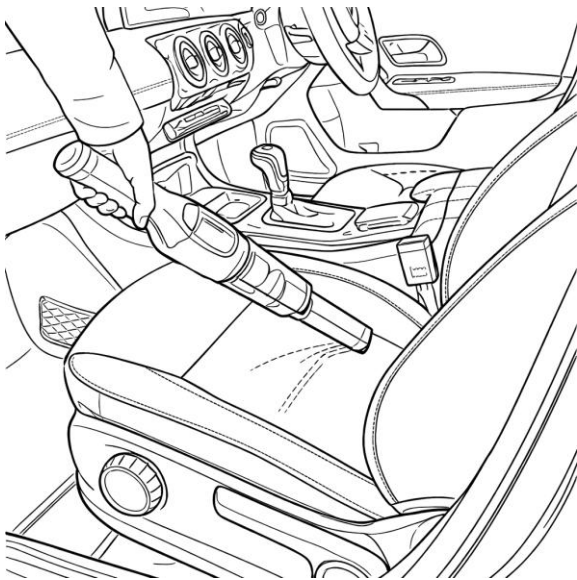
NB If the **Battery/Charging LED** (5) Indicator flashes during use, the internal battery will need recharging.

Step 1

Grasp the vacuum cleaner firmly by the **Handle (2)** and press the **On/off Button (3)** to power up the cleaner.

Step 2

Press the **High/Low button (4)** to select between the high and low suction levels.

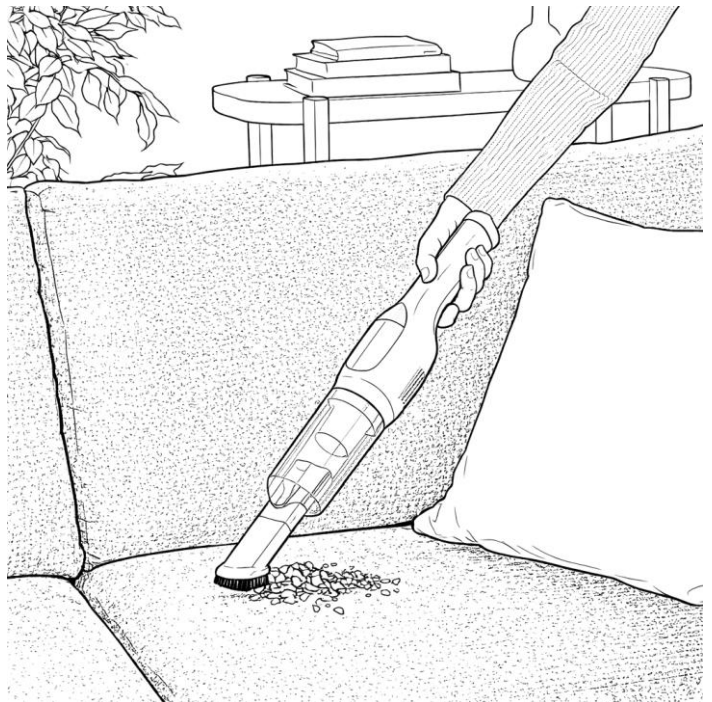


Step 3

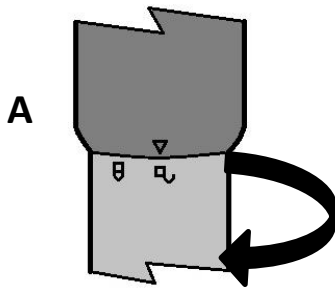
Attach the **Crevice Tool (9)** to the **Air Intake (8)** for those hard to get at places.

Step 4

Attach the **Brush Tool (10)** for use on upholstery, car seats and stairs, etc.

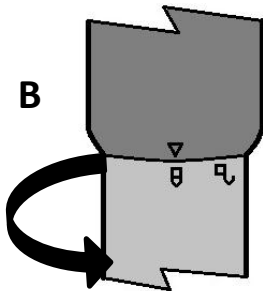


WARNING Always disconnect the cleaner from the **Battery Charger** (12) before emptying.



Step 1

Remove the **Dust Compartment** (7) by holding the **Handle** (2) and twisting the **Dust Compartment** (7) to the left into the unlocked position as in **A** left.



Step 2

Empty the **Dust Compartment** (7) contents into a dust bin as shown right:



Step 3

Replace the **Dust Compartment** (7) by holding the **Handle** (2) and twisting the **Dust Compartment** (7) to the right into the locked position as in **B** left.

WARNING do not continue to use your vacuum cleaner once the **Dust Compartment** (7) is full otherwise permanent damage may occur to the appliance.

Cleaning the Hepa Filter

Step 1

Remove the **Dust Compartment** (7) as described above.



Step 2

Twist the **Hepa Filter** (6) in an anticlockwise direction to remove. Wash the **Hepa Filter** (6) in warm running water until clean. Allow the filter to thoroughly dry for 24 hours before reuse.




Step 3

Replace the filter by twisting onto the vacuum in a clockwise direction.

- Always disconnect the cleaner from the **Battery Charger (12)** before cleaning.
- Clean outside of the cleaner with a clean damp cloth. Never clean with harsh or abrasive cleaners.
- Do not submerge the cleaner in water or any other liquids.
- Empty the **Dust Compartment (7)** as soon as it is full.*
- Clean the Filter regularly – see table below.
- Allow the Hepa filter to thoroughly dry out for 24 hours before reassembly and reuse.

***WARNING** do not continue to use your vacuum cleaner once the **Dust Compartment (7)** is full otherwise permanent damage may occur to the appliance.

Recommended Filter Cleaning Intervals

Filter Type	Recommended cleaning period
Hepa Filter 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shake out debris when you empty the dust container. • Rinse under warm water once a month. • Allow to dry thoroughly for 24 hours before reuse.

WARNING Ensure the filter is cleaned periodically according to the table above, failure to clean the filter regularly will severely impair the performance and permanent damage may occur to the appliance and may also invalidate your warranty.

NB DO NOT under any circumstances use the vacuum cleaner without the filters fitted as damage to the appliance will occur.

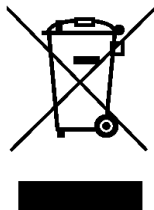
Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No Power	Battery Flat.	Place vacuum on charging station until all three indicator lights are lit.
Low suction or poor pick-up.	Dust Compartment is full. Filters are clogged.	Empty the Dust Compartment. Check and clean the filter.
Low Operating Time	The airflow is restricted	Empty the Dust Compartment. Check and clean the filters.

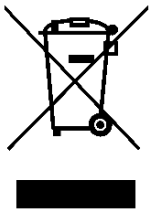
