Before using this product, please read through this manual carefully paying particular attention to the safety instructions. Failure to do so may result in personal injury or damage to the product.

Carefully save this instruction manual for future reference. Ensure the user manual is included when passing the product on to any third parties.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPER USE

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed.

Only use the product as described in this user manual. Any other use is considered improper and may result in damage to property or persons. The manufacturer or vendor cannot be held liable for damages or injury incurred through improper or incorrect use.

- **Read and familiarise yourself with all operating instructions before using this Window Vacuum.**
- Before using your Window Vacuum, visually check that the unit is intact and has not suffered any transit damage.
- Always use this appliance on a solid, level, non-flammable surface.
- Ensure that there is clearance of at least 100mm (4 Inches) minimum around the vacuum for sufficient ventilation.
- Ensure that any ventilation openings are not covered with items, such as newspapers, table-cloths, curtains, etc.
- No naked flame sources, such as lighted candles, should be placed on the vacuum.
- **DO NOT** position the vacuum close to sources of heat such as radiators, heaters, other electronic equipment, etc.
- **DO NOT** immerse the vacuum or its charging cable in water or any other liquids.
- **DO NOT** leave the vacuum unattended during use.
- **DO NOT** leave the vacuum unattended whilst connected to the Charger.
- Close supervision is required when using this Window Vacuum near children.

- Never leave this vacuum within reach of children.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
- Children of less than 3 years should be kept away unless continuously supervised.
- It is imperative to unplug the Charger after the vacuum has been used, before it is cleaned and whilst being repaired.
- Unplug after each use.
- Repairs to electrical appliances should only be performed by qualified personnel. Improper repairs may place the user at serious risk.
- **DO NOT** operate this appliance after a malfunction or after being dropped or damaged in any way.
- **DO NOT** allow the charging cable to hang over sharp edges or come in contact with hot surfaces.
- **DO NOT** run the charging cable under carpets, rugs, etc.
- This product is intended for household use only and should not be used for industrial purposes.
- **DO NOT** use any accessories or attachments with this product other than those supplied or recommended by supplier.
- **DO NOT** use this product for anything other than its intended use.
- **DO NOT** push objects into any openings as damage to the product and/or electric shock may occur.
- Only use this Window Vacuum with the charger supplied.

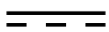

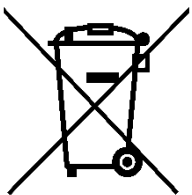

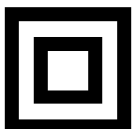

About Your Window Vacuum

Your Daewoo Window Vacuum is designed to clean windows, glass and mirrors quickly and efficiently.

Before the First Use of Your Window Vacuum

Remove all packing materials and discard responsibly.
Ensure all parts are present see - *Description of Parts* below.

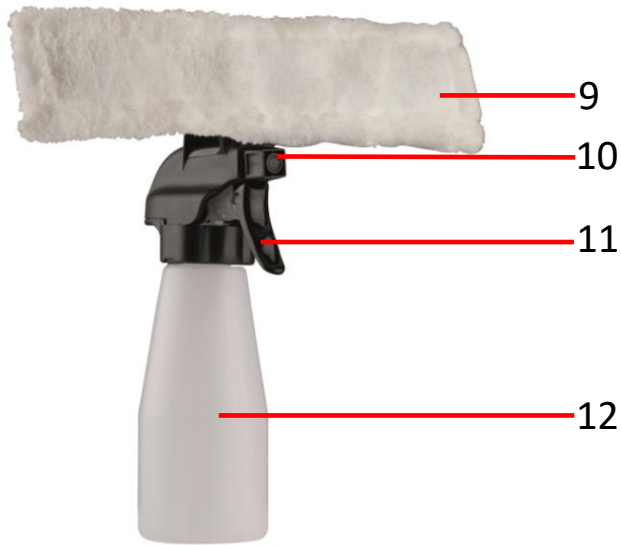
Description of Parts – Window Vacuum



1. Squeegee
2. Squeegee Release Button
3. On/Off Button
4. Handle
5. Dirty Water Plug

6. Dirty Water Tank
7. Charging Port (Behind Cover)
8. Power/Charge Indicator
9. Dirty Water Tank Max Mark

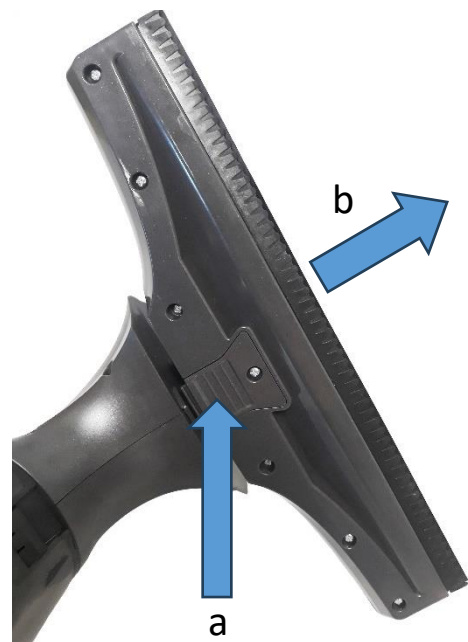
Description of Parts – Cleaning Spray



- 9. Microfibre Cloth
- 10. Spray Nozzle
- 11. Spray Trigger
- 12. Water Bottle
- 13. Mains Charger
- 14. Power Plug



Assembling Your Window Vacuum



1. Push the **Squeegee (1)** onto the window vacuum in the direction of the arrow shown above to attach it to the window vacuum.

2. To remove the **Squeegee (1)**:
 a) Press the **Squeegee Release Button (2)** arrowed above.
 b) Pull the Squeegee away from the window vacuum.

Assembling Your Window Spray

1. Attaching the Spray Mechanism



Insert the spray nozzle into the body of the spray mechanism, push the retaining ring over the spray nozzle to hold it into place.

2. Attaching the Microfibre Cloth



Left: Attach the **Microfibre Cloth** (9) onto the Cleaning Spray by hooking one end of the body into the larger elastic holder and then stretching the smaller elastic holder over the other end. Finally secure the **Microfibre Cloth** (9) to the Window Spray using the Velcro straps.

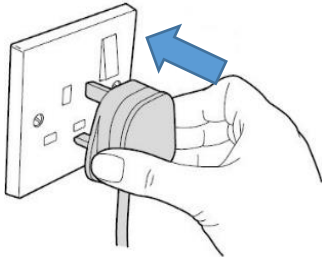
3. Right: Screw the **Water Bottle** (12) onto the Window Spray as shown.



Charging the internal Battery

Before using your Window Vacuum, please ensure that the internal rechargeable battery is fully charged as follows:

1. Insert the **Power Plug (14)** of the **Mains Charger (13)** into the **Charging Port (7)** - under the rubber cover) to charge the internal battery as shown right:



2. Insert the **Mains Charger (13)** into the nearest mains socket and switch the socket on (if applicable).

3. The **Power/Charge Indicator (8)** will flash blue to show the internal battery is charging. Once the battery is fully charged (after approximately 3 hours), the **Power/Charge Indicator (8)** will light blue continuously showing that the internal battery is fully charged and the **Power Plug (14)** can be removed and the Window Vacuum used.

- i** Only use the charger supplied with your window vacuum, using any other kind of charger may permanently damage your product.
- i** The Window vacuum will not operate whilst the **Mains Charger (13)** is connected.

Using Your Window Spray



1. **Left:** Remove the **Water Bottle (12)** from the Window Spray and fill the bottle with water*.

- i** In hard water areas it is strongly recommended that distilled/purified water is used to avoid calcium build up which may damage the Window Vacuum.

2. **Right:** Pull the **Spray Trigger (11)** to spray water onto the surface to be cleaned.
3. Wipe the surface clean using the **Microfibre cloth (9)**.



NOTE You may need to press the trigger several times on first use of the Window Spray to purge the air out of the unit.

Using Your Window Vacuum

1. **Right:** Press and hold the **On/Off Button (3)** to power up the Window Vacuum, the **Power/Charge Indicator (8)** will illuminate.

i Briefly press the **On/Off Button (3)** to switch the vacuum off.



2. **Left:** Vacuum the water using slow, straight, downwards strokes. Ensure the squeegee has good contact with the surface by keeping the vacuum as parallel to the window as possible.

- i** If the **Power/Charger Indicator** (8) flashes during use, the Window Vacuum will require recharging.
- i** The cleaner should not be stored for more than two months without being recharged.

WARNING! Do not operate the cleaner if the water level in the **Dirty Water Tank** (6) exceeds the **Dirty Water Tank MAX Mark** (9). Drain any waste water using the **Dirty Water Plug** (5).

After Every Use



- a. Remove the **Water Bottle** (12) from the Window Spray and empty.



- c. Carefully remove the **Dirty Water Plug** (5) and ensure the **Dirty Water Tank** (6) is empty.

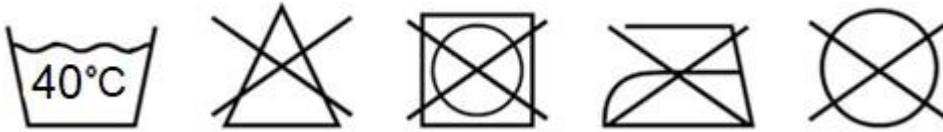


- b. Remove the **Squeegee** (1) and wash it under running water (max. 40°C) to remove dirt & debris. Wipe the squeegee dry.

Care and Use of Your Window Vacuum

- Always disconnect the Window Vacuum from the Charger before cleaning.
- Clean the outside of the Window Vacuum with a clean damp cloth. Never clean with harsh or abrasive cleaners.
- Do not submerge the Window Vacuum or its Charger and cable in water or any other liquids.
- Store the Window Vacuum in a cool dry place away from direct sunlight.

Care and Use of your Microfibre Cloth (9)



- Wash at a maximum temperature of 40°C
- Do not bleach.
- Do not tumble dry.
- Do not iron.
- Do not dry clean.
