READING AND STORING THE USER MANUAL



Before using this product, please read through this manual carefully paying particular attention to the safety instructions. Failure to do so may result in personal injury or damage to the product.

Carefully save this instruction manual for future reference. Ensure the user manual is included when passing the product on to any third parties.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPER USE

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed.

Only use the product as described in this user manual. Any other use is considered improper and may result in damage to property or persons. The manufacturer or vendor cannot be held liable for damages or injury incurred through improper or incorrect use.

- **Read and familiarise yourself with all operating instructions before using this Heated Foot Warmer.**
- Before plugging your unit into the mains, visually check that the unit is intact and has not suffered any transit damage.
- **DO NOT** use this Heated Foot Warmer folded or rucked.
- **DO NOT** insert pins into this Heated Foot Warmer.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years old and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.
- Children shall not play with the appliance.
- Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
- The appliance can be used by children older than 3 years and younger than 8 years under supervision and with the

controller always set to the minimum (1) temperature setting.

- Not to be used by very young children (0-3 years).
- This appliance is not to be used by young children over the age of three unless the controls have been pre-set by a parent or guardian, or unless the child has been adequately instructed on how to operate the controls safely.
- Children under the age of three are not to use this appliance due to their inability to react to overheating.
- If sleeping for long periods of time, use the low heat setting (1) to avoid overheating and discomfort.
- Avoid using the Heated Foot Warmer with the higher heat settings whilst sleeping as this may increase the risk of skin burns and heat stroke.
- Only use the Controller marked on the rating label with this Heated Foot Warmer.
- Whilst storing the Heated Foot Warmer, allow it to fully cool then fold neatly but not tightly or roll loosely avoiding sharp bends in the heating element.
- **DO NOT** crease the appliance by placing other items on top of the Heated Foot Warmer.
- Examine the appliance frequently for signs of wear or damage. If there are such signs, if the appliance has been misused or does not work return it to the supplier before switching it on again.
- This Heated Foot Warmer is for domestic use only and is not intended for commercial use or for use in hospitals.
- **DO NOT** use if damp or wet.
- This appliance must not be used by persons insensitive to heat and other very vulnerable persons who are unable to react to overheating.

- The appliance should not be used on an adjustable bed.
- When in use ensure the Heated Foot Warmer & mains lead do not get trapped.
- The cable and control unit of the appliance can give rise to risks of entanglement, strangulation, tripping or treading if not correctly arranged. The user shall make sure that excess ties and electric cords shall be arranged in a safe way.
- **DO NOT** dry clean this Heated Foot Warmer, for cleaning follow the instructions supplied.
- There are no user serviceable parts, the throw should only be repaired or serviced by a qualified service engineer.
- It is recommended this Heated Foot Warmer is used in conjunction with a residual current device (RCD) with a rated residual operating current not greater than 30mA.
- This Heated Foot Warmer is only for use by humans and shouldn't be used for pets.
- When in use the control unit must not be placed near open windows or inside the Heated Foot Warmer.
- Be sure the Heated Foot Warmer is only connected to an electrical supply as specified in the instructions.
- Switch off the power and remove the plug from the socket outlet when not in use.
- Shoes must be removed before use.
- **It is recommended that this appliance should not be used whilst sleeping.**

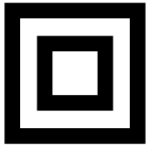

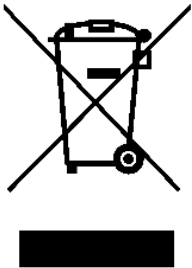

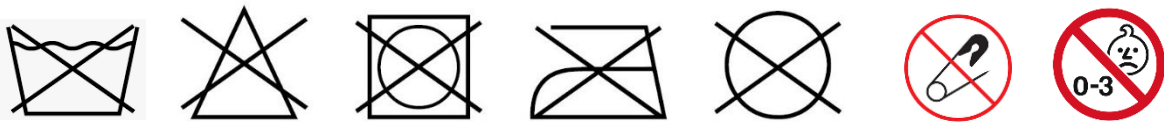
Before first use of Your Heated Foot Warmer

Remove all packing materials and discard responsibly.

Inner lining only maximum washing temperature 40°C  Dry Flat.

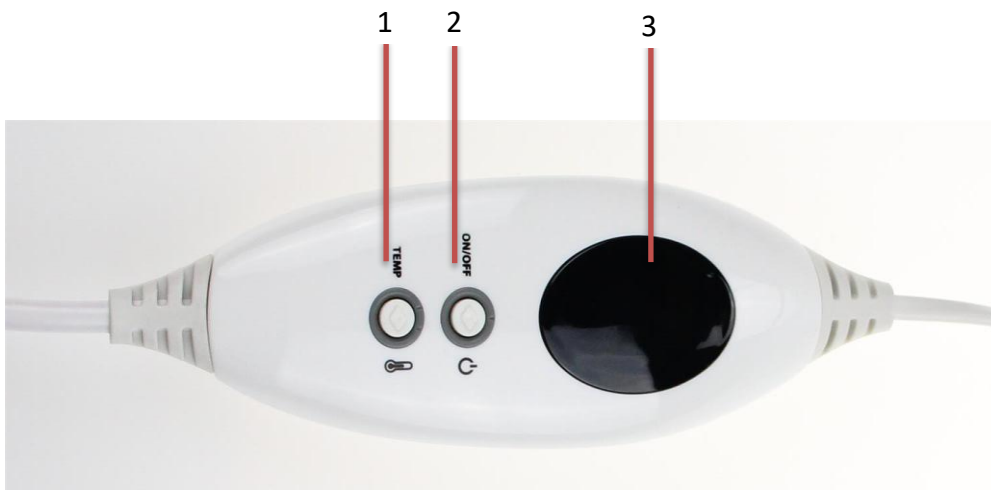
Outer casing DO NOT WASH

- Do not bleach
- Do not tumble dry
- Do not dry clean Do not insert pins
- Not suitable for under 3 years
- Do not iron



⚠ WARNING! DO NOT Immerse the outer casing of the Heated Foot warmer into water or any other liquid.

Description of the Control



1. Temperature Button
2. ON/OFF Button
3. LED Display

Using the Heated Foot Warmer

1. Make sure there is a mains socket nearby when you are going to use the foot Heated Foot Warmer.
2. Insert the mains plug into the mains socket.
3. Press and hold the **ON/OFF button** (2) for 3 seconds, the initial start up will show '3' on the **LED display** (3).
4. The temperature can be set between 1 low to 6 high, to choose the required temperature press the **Temperature Button** (1) repeatedly until you reach the desired setting.
5. If you are going to use the Heated Foot Warmer for a long period of time, it is recommended to use the lowest temperature '1' for comfort.
6. To turn off the Heated Foot warmer, press the **ON/OFF button** (2) for 3 seconds until the **LED display** (3) goes off.

i The Heated Foot Warmer has a built in automatic shut off after 90 minutes.

NOTE: This Heated Foot Warmer should never be used whilst folded as this will cause overheating.

Care and Maintenance

Do not dry clean.

Do not iron.

Do not machine dry.

Spot Cleaning outer casing

Sponge the affected area using a damp cloth.

Inner lining

Use a small amount of detergent and set the washing machine to a “Delicate Wash” with a maximum temperature of 40°. Dry flat.

Non-Rewireable Mains Plug

If your appliance is supplied with a non-rewireable plug fitted to the mains lead and should the fuse needed replacing, you must use an ASTA approved one (conforming to BS 1362 of the same rating). Never use a plug with the fuse cover missing. If in doubt, consult a qualified electrician.

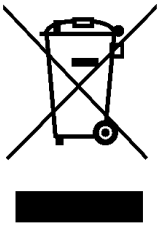

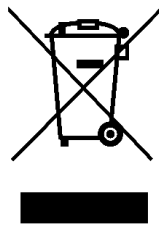
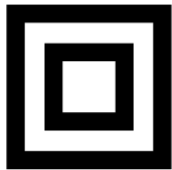
