## READING AND STORING THE USER MANUAL



Before using this product, please read through this manual carefully paying particular attention to the safety instructions. Failure to do so may result in personal injury or damage to the product.

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPER USE

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed.

Only use the product as described in this user manual. Any other use is considered improper and may result in damage to property or persons. The manufacturer or vendor cannot be held liable for damages or injury incurred through improper or incorrect use.

- **Read and familiarise yourself with all operating instructions before using this Plate Warmer.**
- **DO NOT** use this Plate Warmer with a programmer, timer, separate remote-control system or any other device that switches the appliance on automatically.
- **DO NOT** use this Plate Warmer with an extension cable.
- Before plugging your unit into the mains, visually check that the unit is intact and has not suffered any transit damage.
- Check that the voltage indicated on the data plate corresponds with that of the local network before connecting the appliance to the mains power supply.
- Close supervision is required when using this appliance near children.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction

concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children unless they are older than 8 and supervised.

- Keep the appliance and its cord out of reach of children less than 8 years.

**CAUTION** — some parts of this product can become very hot and cause burns. Particular attention has to be given where children and vulnerable people are present.

- Do not use this Plate Warmer in the immediate surroundings of a bath, a shower or a swimming pool.
- **DO NOT** immerse the appliance or its cord in water or any other liquids.
- **DO NOT** leave the appliance unattended during use.
- **DO NOT** leave the appliance unattended whilst connected to the mains supply.
- Always use this appliance on a solid, level, non-flammable surface.
- **DO NOT** use this appliance outdoors.
- It is imperative to unplug the power cord after the appliance has been used, before it is cleaned and whilst being repaired.
- Repairs to electrical appliances should only be performed by a qualified personnel. Improper repairs may place user at serious risk.
- **DO NOT** operate this appliance with a damaged plug or cord, after a malfunction or after being dropped or damaged in any way.
- Regular, periodic checks should be carried out on the mains cable to ensure no damage is evident. Should there

- be any signs of damage the appliance should not be used.
- If the power cable is damaged, it should only be replaced by the manufacturer or suitable qualified personnel in order to avoid a hazard
  - **DO NOT** allow the mains cable to hang over sharp edges or come in contact with hot surfaces.
  - **DO NOT** run the mains cable under carpets, rugs, etc.
  - Allow the unit to cool before storage.
  - Before cleaning, disconnect the appliance from the mains supply and allow to cool.
  - This appliance is intended for household use only and should not be used for industrial purposes.
  - **DO NOT** use any accessories or attachments with this appliance other than those supplied or recommended by supplier.
  - **DO NOT** use this appliance for anything other than its intended use.
  - **DO NOT** push objects into any openings as damage to the appliance and/or electric shock may occur.
  - Ensure appliance is situated in an open area, do not allow it to come in contact with Cupboards, Curtains, wall coverings, clothing or other flammable materials.
  - Unplug after each use. Grasp the plug, not the cord.

## Description of Parts



1. Plate Warmer
2. Power Cord

## Before first use of Your Plate Warmer

Remove all packing materials and discard responsibly.  
Check the heating elements are unfolded inside the cases.  
Ensure the power cord is untangled and out of the pockets before use.

## Operating Instructions

1. There are 5 plate pockets. You may place up to 2 plates in each pocket plus 1 plate beneath and 1 plate on top to heat a total of 12 plates simultaneously.
2. Always have at least 1 plate in each pocket to avoid overheating.
3. Insert the plug into the mains outlet and turn on the switch.
4. It will take a few minutes before the plate warmer feels hot.
5. After 30 minutes, the Plate Warmer will have reached its maximum temperature of 70°C.
6. Always use oven gloves to remove the plates from the heat pockets.
7. Always place the heated plates onto a heat resistant surface or place mat.
8. Allow your Plate Warmer to cool completely before storing after use.

**i** Please note that smaller or thinner plates will heat faster than large thick plates.

## Cleaning and Maintenance

- Remove the plug from the mains socket and allow the Plate Warmer to cool completely before cleaning.
- **DO NOT** immerse the appliance in water or any other liquid.
- Clean the pockets by brushing gently with a soft brush.
- **DO NOT** use scouring pads, steel wool or any type of solvents or abrasive cleaning agents to clean the appliance; they may damage your Plate Warmer.
- The outer fabric cover may be removed and washed as per the instructions on the washing label attached.
- To remove the fabric cover, separate the Velcro fastenings at the top of the cover and take out the inner aluminium element section. Separate cleaning

- instructions are attached to the outer fabric cover and the inner heating element.

**CAUTION: Ensure the plate warmer has fully cooled before carrying out any cleaning or maintenance.**

Allow the cover to fully dry before refitting over the heating element.

**WARNING: Never use the plate warmer without the fabric cover fitted.**  
Never immerse the inner heating element in water or any other liquid.

### ***Non-Wireable Mains Plug***

If your appliance is supplied with a non-wireable plug fitted to the mains lead and should the fuse need replacing, you must use an ASTA approved one (conforming to BS 1362 of the same rating). Never use a plug with the fuse cover missing. If in doubt, consult a qualified electrician.

If you need to remove the plug – DISCONNECT FROM THE MAINS – and then cut it off the mains lead and immediately dispose of it safely. Never attempt to reuse the plug or insert it into a socket outlet as there is a danger of electric shock.

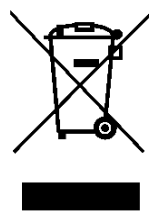
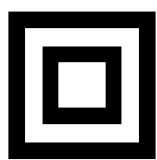
